#### Thimphu Changzamtog Start-Up Centre: A Hub for Entrepreneurship and Innovation

On 25 June 2018, Bhutan inaugurated its first-ever Start-Up Centre in Changzamtog, Thimphu, marking a milestone in the nation's efforts to foster entrepreneurship. Managed by the Department of Employment and Entrepreneurship under the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Employment (MoICE), the centre aims to cultivate a robust start-up ecosystem, driving innovation and economic growth.

The centre comprises three buildings offering 57 workspaces, including 50 incubation units for early-stage ventures. Modern amenities include three conference halls equipped with MI Interactive boards and high-speed internet, ideal for workshops, training sessions, and collaborative programs. These facilities are available for rent at subsidized rates, catering to both resident start-ups and external organizations.

Additional features include co-working spaces for freelancers, a canteen, an Employment Service Centre (ESC), and an Early Child Care and Development Centre (ECCD) dedicated to start-up families. To enhance functionality, the centre is undergoing upgrades to introduce ergonomic furniture, dedicated meeting rooms, collaborative zones, a kitchenette, and versatile workstations, all supported by seamless connectivity.

The centre prioritizes accessibility: any Bhutanese citizen with an innovative business idea—regardless of formal qualifications—can apply for incubation space. Selected ventures enjoy a six-month rent-free period, followed by a nominal fee of Nu. 5.32 per square foot, with tenure extendable for up to three years. This structure allows entrepreneurs to focus on growth without financial strain.

A newly constructed event shed will host large-scale activities such as start-up fairs, weekend markets, promotion and networking events, and start-up challenges, fostering community engagement and visibility. With support from Druk Holding

Investments (DHI), a mini-Fabrication Lab (Fab Lab) is to be established soon, providing cutting-edge tools for prototyping and manufacturing.

Adjacent to the centre, the Department of Industry's Common Facility Centre offers machinery and services for grinding and powdering, design and labelling, packaging, food processing etc enabling start-ups to scale efficiently. Complementary establishment like the Cottage and Small Industry (CSI) Market and Brand Bhutan further assist entrepreneurs in refining products, testing markets, and boosting revenue. Post-incubation, the Department of Industry continues to support ventures through dedicated workspace allocations to further advance their business.

More than a physical space, the Thimphu Changzamtog Start-Up Centre embodies a dynamic ecosystem that nurtures creativity, collaboration, and enterprise. By providing resources, mentorship, and opportunities, it stands as a cornerstone of Bhutan's entrepreneurial landscape, empowering start-ups to thrive and contribute to the nation's sustainable development.

The Mugwort Solution is a startup business located at Startup Center, Changzamtok, Thimphu specializes in making moxa floss/ moxa punk using abundantly and wildly grown Mugwort. The Mugwort Solution will be specialized in making moxa floss (A Cotton Substance) made from the Artemisia Leaves.
